## NOTICE OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO REVIEW ORDER NO. 67 GRANTING RESPONDENTS' MOTION FOR SUMMARY DETERMINATION OF NON-INFRINGEMENT

**SUMMARY**: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission has determined not to review an initial determination ("ID") (Order No. 67) issued by the presiding administrative law judge ("ALJ") granting a motion for summary determination of non-infringement filed by respondents Funai Electric Co., Ltd. of Osaka, Japan; Funai Corporation, Inc. of Rutherford, New Jersey; P&F USA, Inc. of Alpharetta, Georgia; and Funai Service Corporation of Groveport, Ohio (collectively, "Funai").

**SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION**: The Commission instituted this investigation on April 11, 2012, based on a complaint filed by complainants LSI Corporation of Milpitas, California and Agere Systems Inc. of Allentown, Pennsylvania (collectively, "LSI"). 77 Fed. Reg. 22803 (Apr. 11, 2012). The complaint alleged violations of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. § 1337) by reason of infringement of various claims of United States Patent Nos. 5,780,087; 6,452,958; 6,707,867; and 6,982,663. The complaint named several respondents, including Funai; MediaTek Inc. of Hsinchu, Taiwan, MediaTek USA, Inc. of San Jose, California, and MediaTek Wireless, Inc. (USA) of Woburn, Massachusetts; Ralink

Technology Corporation (USA) of Cupertino, CA; and Realtek Semiconductor Corporation of Hsinchu, Taiwan. The Office of Unfair Import Investigation is not a party to this investigation.

On January 29, 2013, Funai moved for summary determination that ten (10) accused Funai products for which expert testimony on infringement was not provided do not infringe the asserted patents. On February 27, 2013, the ALJ issued the subject ID ("Order No. 67") granting Funai's motion for summary determination. On March 8, 2013, LSI filed a petition for review of the ID. On March 14, 2013, Funai filed an opposition.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in Section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. § 1337), and in sections 210.18 and 210.42-43 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 C.F.R. §§ 210.18 & 210.42-43).
