II. Suggested article description(s) for enactment (including appropriate HTS subheading(s)):

Torches designed for outdoor use, with poles of bamboo, measuring 160 cm or less in height and designed for use with refillable metal fuel canisters, each fitted with a wick (provided for in subheading 9405.50.40)

(If enacted, the tariff relief provided for in this bill would be available to any entity that imports the product that is covered by the bill.)

III. Other product information, including uses/applications and source(s) of imports

These articles are outdoor, open-flame lighting and use oil as a fuel source. The wick is made of fiberglass. The oil sits in a metal fuel canister that fits inside a decorative vessel. Imports under HTS subheading 9405.50.40 amounted to \$322 million in 2011, with China accounting for 77 percent of the total. India was the second-leading supplier, accounting for 14 percent. The use of bamboo poles gives the torches a tropical or Polynesian appearance.
