
NOTICE OF INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF SECTION 337 AND  
RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BOND

On this date, and pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 85 Fed. Reg. 67010 (Oct. 21, 2020), I issued the final initial determination in this matter. 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.10(b), 210.42(a)(1)(i). As explained in that determination, I have determined that a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, has occurred in the importation into the United States and the sale within the United States after importation of certain shingled solar modules, components thereof, and methods for manufacturing the same based on infringement of U.S. Patent No. 10,763,388 and U.S. Patent No. 10,651,333.
