QUARTERLY REPORT ON CERTAIN STAINLESS STEEL AND ALLOY TOOL STEEL

HIGHLIGHTS

During the fourth quarter (October-December) 1986, compared to the third quarter of 1986:

- DOMESTIC PRODUCTION of the stainless steel and alloy tool steel products covered by the investigation increased 13 percent to 269,242 tons; increases occurred in the stainless sheet and strip, plate, and wire rod product categories.
- U.S. PRODUCERS' SHIPMENTS rose 8 percent to 266,816 tons.
- AVERAGE EMPLOYMENT of production and related workers decreased 0.9 percent to 10,543 workers.
- U.S. PRODUCERS' AND IMPORTERS' PRICES showed noteworthy declines and increases among products. There were more declines than increases in producers' prices compared with the previous quarter, but importers' prices showed a fairly equal number of price increases and decreases.
- U.S. IMPORTERS' UNFILLED ORDERS decreased 25 percent to 34,258 tons.
- U.S. IMPORTERS' INVENTORIES increased 12 percent to 23,981 tons.

U.S. production and producers' shipments

U.S. production of the stainless steel and alloy tool steel products covered by the investigation increased overall from July-September 1986 to October-December 1986. There were production increases in the stainless sheet and strip, plate, and wire rod product categories, partly reflecting renewed activity following traditional summer vacation schedules and reductions in plant operations during the third quarter. There were also increases in shipments in these three product categories during the fourth quarter.

Employment and hours worked

The average number of all persons employed in producing the subject stainless steel and alloy tool steel decreased from 14,897 persons to 14,646 persons, or by 2 percent, from July-September 1986 to October-December 1986. Employment of production and related workers fell from 10,636 workers to 10,543 workers, or by 1 percent, over the same period. Total employment, and production and related worker employment, have been decreasing steadily since the second quarter of 1984. The number of hours worked by production and related workers increased by 2 percent during the period.

U.S. producers' prices

Surveys of the weighted average prices of selected domestic stainless steel and alloy tool steel products showed more price declines than increases between July 1986 and December 1986 for sales to both service centers and end-users. The trend in producers' prices continues the downward pattern that occurred during the first half of 1986. The most noteworthy price decrease was for * * *.

U.S. importers' prices

Pricing data reported by U.S. importers for certain stainless steel and alloy tool steel products revealed a fairly equal number of price increases and decreases between July 1986 and December 1986. This fluctuating pattern has generally characterized importers' prices since early 1985.

U.S. importers' unfilled orders and inventories

Data on importers' unfilled orders from foreign sources indicate an overall decrease between September 30, 1986 and December 31, 1986. There were decreases in such orders for * * * and increases in orders for * * * during the period. Importers' inventories of * * * decreased between the two quarters, while inventories of * * * rose.
