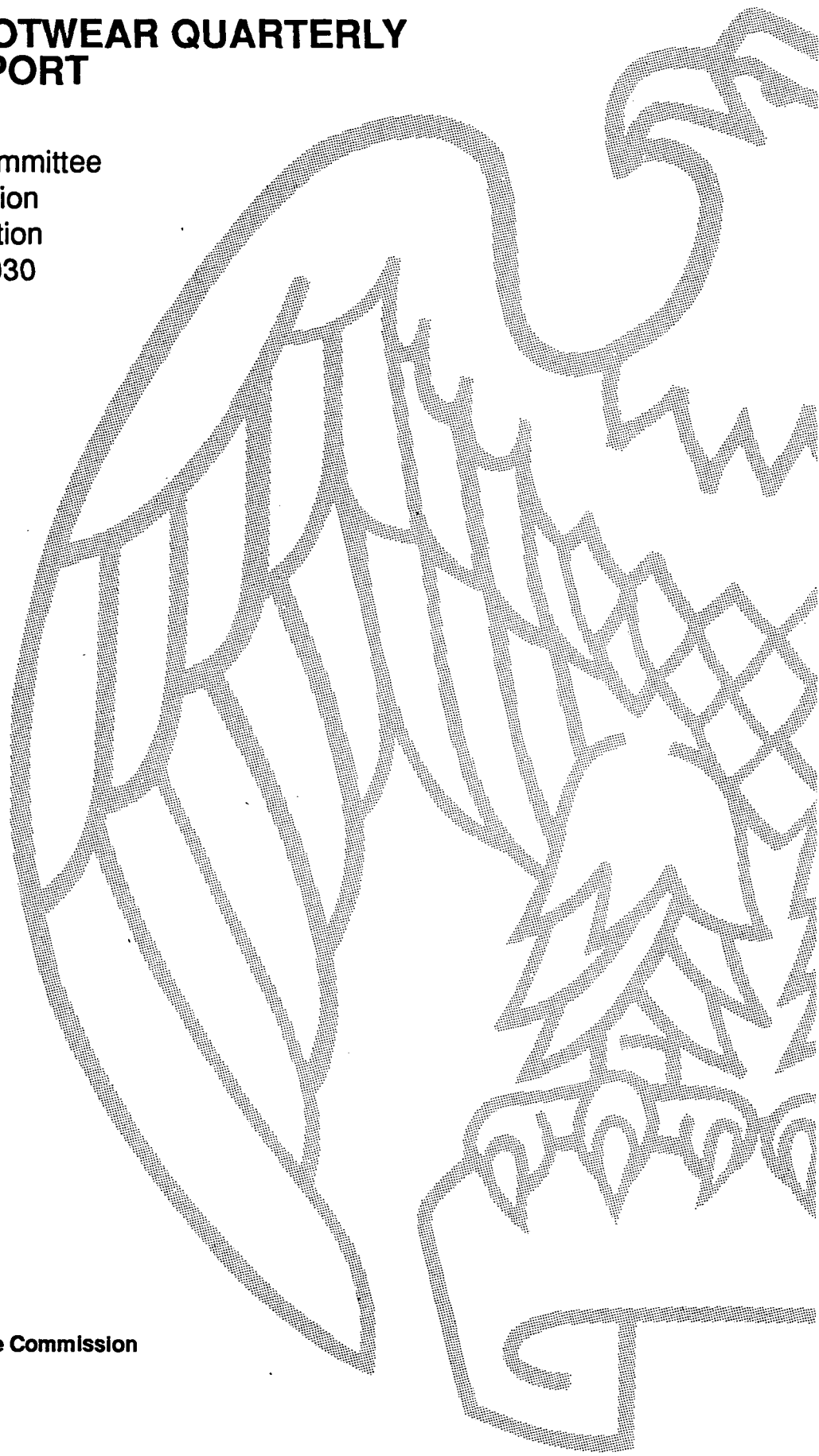

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HIGHLIGHTS

U.S. production.--Although U.S. nonrubber footwear production dropped by 1 percent in October-December of 1992 from that in the corresponding period of 1991, production for all of 1992 rose by 1 percent, the first annual increase since 1988. The value of U.S. producers' shipments was up by 28 percent in the fourth quarter of 1992 over that in the corresponding period in 1991, marking the second consecutive quarter in which shipments exceeded \$1 billion. For all of 1992, shipments increased by 9 percent, to a record \$3.8 billion.

The U.S. industry's share of domestic consumption, by quantity, again declined in 1992, by 1 percentage point, to 13 percent. By value, however, it rose by 6 percentage points, to 33 percent, for the fourth quarter and by 1 percentage point, to 29 percent, for the year. Continuing a long-term decline, total industry employment fell slightly in 1992 as did the number of production workers. The unemployment rate for the year rose slightly to 12.6 percent from 12.4 percent in 1991.

U.S. imports.--Nonrubber footwear imports reached their highest level ever in 1992 by both volume and value. Their share of the total U.S. market reached a new high of 87 percent by volume but fell slightly by value to 71 percent.

The rise in U.S. imports from China, the leading import supplier, continued to slow in 1992, to 19.2 percent by volume and 31.6 percent by value over 1991 (compared with increases of 86 and 127 percent, respectively, from 1989 to 1990, and of 59 and 77 percent, respectively, from 1990 to 1991). China's share of total U.S. imports grew from 45 percent in 1991 to 52 percent in 1992. Its share of U.S. apparent consumption grew from 40 to 45 percent. U.S. imports from Brazil continued to grow, with Brazil surpassing Korea and Taiwan in 1992 to attain a position as the United States' second largest supplier, with 11 percent of total imports by volume and 13 percent by value. The volume of imports from Indonesia rose by 51 percent, making it the third largest supplier, with 8 percent of total imports. The volume of imports from Taiwan and Korea continued to drop (by 38 and 36 percent, respectively) putting them in fourth (8 percent) and fifth (7 percent) place as suppliers of U.S. footwear imports. In terms of value, Korea was the third largest supplier of footwear to the United States, followed by Italy, Indonesia, and Taiwan.
