INTRODUCTION

This series of quarterly reports by the U.S. International Trade Commission is made pursuant to title IV, section 410 of the Trade Act of 1974,¹ which requires the Commission to monitor the flow of imports and exports between the United States and certain other countries.² These countries include, on the one hand, those that are accorded most-favored-nation (MFN) status under the freedom-of-emigration requirements of section 402 (the Jackson-Vanik amendment) of the 1974 Trade Act and, on the other hand, those that are listed in general note 3(b) of the *Harmonized Tariff Schedule of the United States (HTS)*.³ The countries receiving MFN tariff treatment are subject to the rates of duty in the general subcolumn of column 1 of the *HTS*, whereas the remainder of the countries monitored by this series of reports are subject to the generally higher statutory rates of duty in column 2.⁴ The monitored countries with MFN status as of the end of the quarter under review were as follows: Albania, Armenia, Belarus, Bulgaria, China, Georgia, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Mongolia, Romania, Russia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Ukraine, and Uzbekistan.

² Section 410 requires the Commission to monitor the flow of imports and exports between the United States and "nonmarket economy countries." However, since a number of the countries whose trade is covered under section 410 have rejected central economic planning, the term "nonmarket economy" is no longer used in this series of reports.

³ As of March 31, 1995, general note 3(b) of the *HTS* applied to the following countries in this report: Azerbaijan, Cambodia, Cuba, Laos, North Korea, and Vietnam.

⁴ The column 2 rates of duty are, in general, the full rates that were established by the Tariff Act of 1930.

Tables on trade with all of the monitored countries collectively and individually appear in chapters 1, 2, 3, and 4. However, the term "monitored countries" does not include those countries subject to title IV of the 1974 Trade Act that are also under embargo. Tables showing the few items, if any, traded with each of the embargoed countries (Cuba and North Korea) can be found in chapter 5. All countries with the exception of those under embargo are included in totals designated as "all monitored countries."

The trade data in this series of reports are compiled from official statistics of the U.S. Bureau of the Census. Imports are "imports for consumption," amounting to the sum of directly entered imports plus withdrawals from customs warehouses, at customs value, which is generally equivalent to free on board (f.o.b.) value at the foreign port of export. Exports are "domestic exports." U.S.-produced goods, at free alongside ship (f.a.s.) value at the U.S. port. All data in this series are presented in terms of the *Harmonized System (HS)*. The most detailed presentation of imports in these chapters is based on the six-digit subheadings of the *HTS*, and that of exports is based on the six-digit subheadings of the *HS-based Schedule B* (1990 edition). Aggregate trade levels and trends are presented in terms of *HTS* and of *Harmonized System-based Schedule B* sections, chapters (two-digit numbers), and headings (four-digit numbers).⁵

This quarterly report contains tables on U.S. trade with the monitored countries during January-March 1995.

⁵ The *Harmonized System* is a hierarchical coding system, with the first two digits of a six-digit subheading representing a chapter in a section, the third and fourth digits a heading in a chapter, and the fifth and sixth digits a subheading in a heading.



CHAPTER 2




