The Commission will hold this hearing using the GoToMeeting videoconference platform.

- Once a slot is designated for you, you will receive an email with instructions concerning how to log in to the hearing. You may not share the log-in information. It is for your use only.
- Parties and witnesses will be assigned a slot upon acceptance of their formal request to appear at the hearing (see "Important" note below). However, in order to receive log-in information, these participants must provide an email address by sending an email to commissionhearings@usitc.gov. Entities with multiple participants must obtain a separate slot for each individual in their group.

IMPORTANT -- Registering for a slot DOES NOT constitute an official request to appear and give testimony at the hearing.

- **The deadline to submit a request to appear and give testimony for this hearing has passed. All accepted witnesses will receive official notification by the USITC Office of the Secretary.**
- **All witnesses must file an electronic copy of their testimony through EDIS no later than 12pm (noon) on June 17, 2020.**
- **All documents, including testimony, must be filed through the Commission's Electronic Document Information System (<https://edis.usitc.gov>).** No in-person paper-based filings or paper copies of any electronic filings will be accepted until further notice.
