

NOTICE OF INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF SECTION 337 AND
RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BOND

(July 12, 2019)

On this date, and pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 83 Fed. Reg. 32686 (July 13, 2018), I issued the final Initial Determination in the matter of *Certain Convertible Sofas and Components*, Investigation No. 337-TA-1122. 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.10(b), 210.42(a)(1)(i). As explained in that determination, I have determined that no violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act, as amended, has occurred in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation, of certain convertible sofas and components thereof based on allegations of infringement of U.S. Design Patent No. 716, 576.
