337 AND RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BOND



Pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 82 *Fed. Reg.* 19081 (Apr. 25, 2017), this is the Initial Determination in the matter of *Certain Dental Ceramics, Products Thereof, and Methods of Making the Same*, Investigation No. 337-TA-1050.

It is held that that no violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, has occurred in the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or the sale within the United States after importation of certain dental ceramics, products thereof, and methods of making the same with respect to U.S. Patents Nos. 7,452,836 and 6,802,894.
