

**NOTICE OF INITIAL DETERMINATION ON VIOLATION OF SECTION 337 AND  
RECOMMENDED DETERMINATION ON REMEDY AND BOND**

(November 19, 2021)

On this date, and pursuant to the Notice of Investigation, 85 Fed. Reg. 62761 (October 5, 2020), I issued the final initial determination in this matter. 19 C.F.R. §§ 210.10(b), 210.42(a)(1)(i). As explained in that determination, I have determined that no violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, has occurred in the importation into the United States and the sale within the United States after importation of certain light-emitting diodes and products containing the same based on infringement of U.S. Patent No. 9,240,529; U.S. Patent No. 9,859,464; U.S. Patent No. 10,593,854; or U.S. Patent No. 10,658,557.
