**ORDER DENYING REQUEST FOR ENTRY INTO EARLY DISPOSITION PROGRAM**

On July 21, 2020, proposed Respondent The Chamberlain Group, Inc., submitted a letter requesting that the Commission designate the issue of patent-eligibility under 35 U.S.C. § 101, for the six asserted patents, for an early ruling by the ALJ within 100 days of any institution. *See* EDIS Doc. ID 715219.

The Commission has determined not to use the Early Disposition Program pursuant to 19 C.F.R. § 210.10(b)(3) for this investigation because the suggested issues for resolution may be too complex to be decided within 100 days of institution. Accordingly, the Commission hereby **DENIES** the Request.
