**NOTICE OF A COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO REVIEW AN INITIAL
DETERMINATION SETTING THE TARGET DATE**

AGENCY: U.S. International Trade Commission.

ACTION: Notice.

SUMMARY: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission (“Commission”) has determined not to review an initial determination (“ID”) (Order No. 3) of the presiding administrative law judge (“ALJ”), setting the target date for the completion of this investigation as May 17, 2023, with the final ID on violation to issue by January 17, 2023.

SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION: The Commission instituted this investigation on November 2, 2021, based on a complaint filed on behalf of Bell Northern Research, LLC of Chicago, Illinois. 86 FR 60467 (Nov. 2, 2021). The complaint alleged a violation of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337, based upon the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, and the sale within the United States after importation of certain electronic devices having wireless communication capabilities and components thereof by reason of infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent Nos. 8,204,554; 7,319,889; RE 48,629; and 8,416,862. *Id.* at 60467–68. The complaint further alleged that an industry in the United States exists as required by section 337. *Id.* The Commission’s notice of investigation named the following as respondents: Lenovo Group Ltd. of Beijing, China; Lenovo (United States), Inc. of Morrisville, North Carolina; Motorola Mobility LLC of Chicago, Illinois; TCL Electronics Holdings Limited of Hong Kong, China; TCT Mobile (US) Inc. of Irvine, California;

TTE Technology, Inc. of Corona, California; BLU Products, Inc. of Doral, Florida; BBK Electronics Corp. of Dongguan, China; OnePlus Technology Co., Ltd. of Shenzhen, China; HMD Global Oy of Espoo, Finland; HMD America, Inc. of Miami, Florida; and Sonim Technologies, Inc. of Austin, Texas. *Id.* The Office of Unfair Import Investigations was named as a party in this investigation. *Id.*

On November 17, 2021, the ALJ issued Order No. 3, the subject ID, which set the target date for the completion of this investigation as May 17, 2023 (approximately 18.5 months from institution), with the final ID on violation to issue by January 17, 2023. No petitions for review of the ID were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID.

Accordingly, the target date is May 17, 2023, and the final initial determination is due on January 17, 2023.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on December 14, 2021.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 CFR Part 210).
