NOTICE OF A COMMISSION DETERMINATION NOT TO REVIEW AN INITIAL DETERMINATION TERMINATING THE INVESTIGATION AS TO ONE RESPONDENT BASED ON CONSENT ORDER; ISSUANCE OF A CONSENT ORDER

**AGENCY**: U.S. International Trade Commission.

**ACTION**: Notice.

**SUMMARY**: Notice is hereby given that the U.S. International Trade Commission has determined not to review an initial determination ("ID") (Order No. 19) issued by the presiding administrative law judge ("ALJ") granting an unopposed motion to terminate respondent Eunsung Global Corp. ("Eunsung") from this investigation based on a consent order stipulation and consent order. The Commission issues a consent order directed to Eunsung.

**SUPPLEMENTARY INFORMATION**: On July 17, 2024, the Commission instituted this investigation based on a complaint filed on behalf of HydraFacial LLC, f/k/a Edge Systems LLC, of Long Beach, California. 89 FR 58188–89 (Jul. 17, 2024). The complaint alleges violations of section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. 1337 based on the importation into the United States, the sale for importation, or sale within the United States after importation of certain hydrodermabrasion systems and components thereof by reason of the infringement of certain claims of U.S. Patent No. 11,865,287. *Id.* The complaint further alleges that an industry in the United States exists as required by section 337. *Id.* The Commission's notice of investigation named as respondents Eunsung of Republic of Korea, and Cartessa Aesthetics,

LLC of Melville, New York. *Id.* The Office of Unfair Import Investigations is not participating in this investigation. *Id.* 

On October 15, 2024, respondent Eunsung filed an unopposed motion to terminate the investigation as to it based on a consent order stipulation and proposed consent order.

On December 19, 2024, the ALJ issued Order No. 19, the subject ID, which granted the motion pursuant to Commission Rule 210.21(c) (19 CFR 210.21(c)). The ID found that the motion includes the required statement that "there are no other agreements, written or oral, express or implied between Eunsung and HydraFacial concerning the subject matter of the investigation." Order No. 19 at 5. The ID further found that the motion attaches a consent order stipulation that complies with Commission Rule 210.21(c)(3) (19 CFR 210.21(c)(3)) and a consent order that complies with Commission Rule 210.21(c)(4) (19 CFR 210.21(c)(4)). *Id.* The ID also found that any effect the proposed consent order may have on the statutory public interest factors does not counsel against entry of the order. *Id.* at 10. No petitions for review of the ID were filed.

The Commission has determined not to review the subject ID. Eunsung is terminated from this investigation based on a consent order issued herewith.

The Commission vote for this determination took place on January 21, 2025.

The authority for the Commission's determination is contained in section 337 of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended (19 U.S.C. 1337), and in Part 210 of the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (19 CFR Part 210).
