The Commission is in receipt of your April 20, 2018 letter requesting a postponement of the deadline by which the Commission must decide whether to institute a Section 337 investigation concerning Certain Human Milk Oligosaccharides and Methods of Producing the Same (Docket No. 3306).

Under Commission Rule 210.10(a)(1), 19 C.F.R. § 210.10(a)(1), the Commission may extend the deadline for voting on institution of an investigation based upon a request by a complainant. Rule 210.10(a)(4), 19 C.F.R. § 210.10(a)(4), authorizes the Commission to reschedule the determination on institution "for whatever date is appropriate in light of the facts."

The Commission has determined to postpone its vote on institution, and has determined that the new deadline is set for May 16, 2018.
