The United States International Trade Commission is investigating steel concrete reinforcing bar ("rebar") under the provisions of sections 701 and 731 of the Tariff Act of 1930.

In this proceeding, the Commission must determine whether an industry in the United States is materially injured or is threatened with material injury, or the establishment of an industry in the United States is materially retarded, by reason of imports from Mexico and Turkey of rebar that are alleged to be sold in the United States at less than fair value, and by reason of imports from Turkey that are alleged to be subsidized by the Government of Turkey.
