3 CHAIRMAN WILLIAMSON: Good morning. This meeting  
4 of the U.S. International Trade Commission will now come to  
5 order. Welcome to Commissioner Kieff who is participating  
6 by telephone.

7 COMMISSIONER KIEFF: Hello.

8 CHAIRMAN WILLIAMSON: Good Morning. I understand  
9 that there are no agendas for future meetings, minutes,  
10 ratification lists or outstanding action jackets to  
11 consider.

12 Next we turn to the vote in Investigations number  
13 701-TA-549 and 731-TA-1299-1300 and 1302--1303 (Final),  
14 Circular Welded Carbon-Quality Steel Pipe from Oman,  
15 Pakistan, the United Arab Emirates, and Vietnam.
