- 13 2014. Throughout his tenure in the Office of
- 14 Investigations, Fred has demonstrated a keen ability to
- 15 identify and meet the agency's investigation needs.
- The office has relied on Fred's technical
- 17 ability, as well as over the years as it has continued to
- 18 upgrade and improve its data collection efforts, its
- 19 analysis, and the integrity of its procedures, including
- 20 the leap from snail mail to e-mail for the filing of
- 21 questionnaires.
- 22 Fred has tirelessly mentored new staff and
- 23 stepped in to fill needs when personnel gaps opened up. He
- 24 has been an essential resource who readily shares his
- 25 extensive knowledge and experience regarding Title VII

- 1 procedures and activities. Fred has been one of the
- 2 Commission's great assets.
- I would like to thank you very much for your many
- 4 years of service, and wish you all the best in your
- 5 retirement.
- 6 MR. RUGGLES: Thank you.
- 7 (Applause.)
- 8 CHAIRMAN SCHMIDTLEIN: Would you like to say
- 9 anything, Fred? No?
- 10 (Laughter.)
- 11 CHAIRMAN SCHMIDTLEIN: Okay.
- 12 COMMISSIONER WILLIAMSON: I just wanted to second
- 13 all the comments that the Chairman has made. And I also
- 14 want to thank Fred for his contributions to the ITC
- 15 community. He has done those things with humor, vigor, and
- 16 energy, and we are really going to miss all of those
- 17 attributes. And we wish him all the best going forward.
- MR. RUGGLES: Thank you.
- 19 VICE CHAIRMAN JOHANSON: Fred, thanks for your
- 20 many years of service to the Commission. I know you've
- 21 been around a long time because I remember seeing your name
- 22 in Federal Register notices back when I was practicing law,
- 23 which was about 15, over 15 years ago.
- I believe you are a friend of Eric Solwinin, who
- 25 I used to have the pleasure to work with, and he used to
