EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATIONS ON ADEQUACY

Boltless Steel Shelving Units Prepackaged for Sale from China Inv. Nos. 701-TA-523 and 731-TA-1259 (Review)

On December 7, 2020, the Commission determined to conduct expedited five-year reviews in the above-referenced proceedings pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930 (19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B)).

The Commission received one response to its notice of institution. It was filed by Edsal Manufacturing Company, LLC ("Edsal"), a domestic producer of boltless steel shelving. The Commission found that the individual response that Edsal submitted was adequate. Because Edsal accounted for a substantial share of domestic production of boltless steel shelving in 2019, the Commission determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate in each review.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any importer, exporter, or producer of subject merchandise from China that supported revocation of the orders in these reviews. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response in each review was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting full reviews of the orders. Therefore, the Commission decided to conduct expedited reviews of the orders.
