

## EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

In

*Certain Tow-Behind Lawn Groomers and Parts Thereof from China*  
Inv. No. 731-TA-1153 (Second Review)

On April 6, 2020, the Commission determined to conduct an expedited review in the subject five-year review pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a response to its notice of institution from Agri-Fab, Inc. (“Agri-Fab”), a domestic producer of tow-behind lawn groomers (“TBLGs”). The Commission found Agri-Fab’s individual response to be adequate. Because Agri-Fab accounted for a substantial share of U.S. production of TBLGs in 2019, the Commission determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any respondent party in this review. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting a full review. Therefore, the Commission decided to conduct an expedited review of this order.
