EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATIONS ON ADEQUACY

In

Certain Coated Paper Suitable for High-Quality Print Graphics Using Sheet-Fed Presses from China and Indonesia

Inv. Nos. 701-TA-470-471 and 731-TA-1169-1170 (Second Review)

On March 7, 2022, the Commission determined to conduct expedited reviews in the subject five-year reviews pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a joint response to the notice of institution from Verso Corporation, and Sappi North America, Inc., two U.S. producers of certain coated paper suitable for high-quality print graphics using sheet-fed presses ("coated paper"), and from the United Steel, Paper and Forestry, Rubber, Manufacturing, Energy, Allied Industrial and Service Workers International Union, AFL-CIO, CLC, which represents workers at domestic coated paper production facilities.

The Commission found each domestic interested party's response to be individually adequate. The Commission further determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate because the responding domestic producers accounted for a substantial portion of domestic coated paper production in 2020.

No respondent interested party filed a response to the notice of institution. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group responses were inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting full reviews. It therefore determined to conduct expedited reviews of the orders.
