

## EXPLANATION OF COMMISSION DETERMINATION ON ADEQUACY

in

*Glycine from China*

Inv. No. 731-TA-718 (Fifth Review)

On April 8, 2022, the Commission determined to conduct an expedited review in the subject five-year review pursuant to section 751(c)(3)(B) of the Tariff Act of 1930, as amended, 19 U.S.C. § 1675(c)(3)(B).

The Commission received a response to its notice of institution on behalf of GEO Specialty Chemicals, Inc. (“GEO”), a domestic producer of glycine. It found GEO’s response to be individually adequate. Because GEO accounted for a substantial percentage of domestic glycine production in 2021, the Commission determined that the domestic interested party group response was adequate.

The Commission did not receive a response to the notice of institution from any respondent interested party. Consequently, the Commission determined that the respondent interested party group response was inadequate.

The Commission did not find any circumstances that would warrant conducting a full review. Therefore, the Commission determined to conduct an expedited review of the order.
